Join us at The Makery for our Creative Camps this summer --a great opportunity to come learn something new at our fiber arts and bookbinding/paper arts day camps for kids ages 8 through teens.

At each camp, kids will learn new skills and make fun stuff to take home with them. At the end of the week, we will have an exhibition where they will display their work for family and friends!

The registration fee for each camp week includes all instruction and materials for one week of morning sessions (for kids ages 8 to 12) or afternoon sessions (for teenagers), where we will explore at least four different techniques together and work on several projects that the kids will take home at the end of the week. Registration also includes a daily snack and a camp bag.

*Each week is independent of the other, so kids can choose to take one or both weeks. We will cover different techniques each week of camp.*

**There is a minimum number of 4 campers each week, and a maximum of 8. Reserve your spot now!**

## **CREATIVE CAMPS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE**

### **Kid Camp/FIBER**

Weaving (several different small looms + floor loom), knitting without needles (finger, spool, and loom knitting), felting (wet felting, Nuno felting), Kool-Aid dyeing, fabric painting, stamp making. Projects completed\*: small woven bag, knitted bracelet or necklace, felted beads and a scarf, handprinted bag.

**June 12-16 (Monday to Friday) – 9 a.m. to Noon daily (Register by 6/9)  
\$125 (includes all instruction + materials + daily snack + camp bag)**

### **Kid Camp/PAPER**

Papermaking, paper pulp beads, bookbinding (stab binding, accordion binding, pamphlet stitch), surface design (marbling, paste paper, Gelli plate monoprints, soap bubble paper, salt paper). Projects completed\*: handmade paper, paper pulp bead bracelet or necklace, three blank hand-bound books, several sheets of hand-decorated paper.

**July 17-21 (Monday to Friday) – 9 a.m. to Noon daily (Register by 7/14)  
\$125 (includes all instruction + materials + daily snack + camp bag)**

### **Teen Camp/FIBER**

Weaving (backstrap loom + floor loom), spinning yarn (spindle + wheel), needle tatting, sewing with upcycled felt, needle felting. Projects completed\*: backstrap loom with handwoven backstrap—woven by you!, skein of handspun yarn, needle-tatted anklet or bracelet, hand-felted cup cozy or bag.

**June 26-30 (Monday to Friday) – 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. daily (Register by 6/23)  
\$165 (includes all instruction + materials + daily snack + camp bag)**

### **Teen Camp/PAPER**

Bookbinding (long stitch, Secret Belgian, French link stitch, pop-ups, surface design (Gelli plate monoprints, suminagashi, marbling, paste paper), papermaking. Projects completed\*: three blank hand-bound books, handmade paper, pop-up cards, several sheets of hand-decorated paper.

**July 24-28 (Monday to Friday) – 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. daily (Register by 7/21)  
\$165 (includes all instruction + materials + daily snack + camp bag)**

\*Projects may change depending on campers' skill level and preferences.

## OUR GOAL

Through daily exposure to fiber or paper arts techniques, campers will nurture their creativity and curiosity, develop lifelong skills, make new friends, and have fun! Campers will visit The Makery daily for three hours (8-12 year olds) or four hours (teenagers), where they will learn and practice new skills in a project-based environment. Each weekly session will conclude on Friday with an Open House and Exhibition in the afternoon, where family and friends are invited to view campers' projects on display.

We pride ourselves on teaching serious skills that each camper will be able to carry on with after the week of camp is over—we are not simply engaging in busy work to keep a child entertained for a short amount of time, but teaching serious skills (in a fun way!) that they will be able to use and expand upon for the rest of their lives. All equipment and materials will be provided, and we are happy to help parents source both for their children to continue on after the week of camp is over. A week of learning, a lifetime of fun!
